Works in conjunction with community resources. Is responsible to the Program Supervisor.

- Minimum of two years experience in child & family services or related social services

- Demonstrated knowledge of First Nations organizations / groups / elders in the community

- Willing to work on a flex – time work schedule
- Excellent work record/history
- Awareness and respect for the Dakota and Ojibway a definite asset
